

Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement

This statement sets out the steps that Grainco Ltd., hereinafter referred to as 'the Company', has taken to ensure that slavery and human trafficking is not taking place in any part of our business or to the best of our knowledge any of our supply chains.

Our Business: The Company head office is located at Tyne Dock in South Shields. It provides services and products including the marketing of combinable crops, seed and fertiliser. We also undertake haulage and storage of crops and the processing of seeds.

Ethical Standards: The risk of human trafficking and slavery within our business is mitigated by our membership of SEDEX (Supplier Ethical Data Exchange).

Our Supply Chains: The majority of our products are agricultural crops, seed and fertiliser which are predominantly purchased in the European Union. Products are sourced direct from farmers or quality assured merchants.

Risk Assessment: The company may undertake periodic risk assessments covering all areas of our business and supply chain to identify any slavery and human trafficking high-risk areas.

Monitoring and Compliance: As part of the Company's due diligence process we will correspond with members of our supply chain to ensure our suppliers are aware of the Modern Slavery Act 2015.

Training: All employees will receive refresher training at regular intervals in relation to the company's Anti-Slavery policy.

This statement is made pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015.

This statement will be reviewed on an annual basis.
